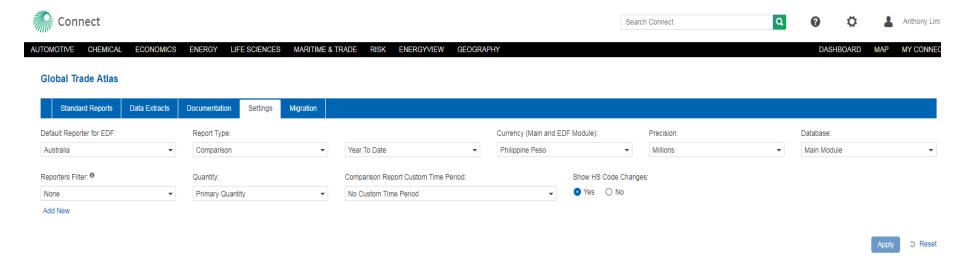
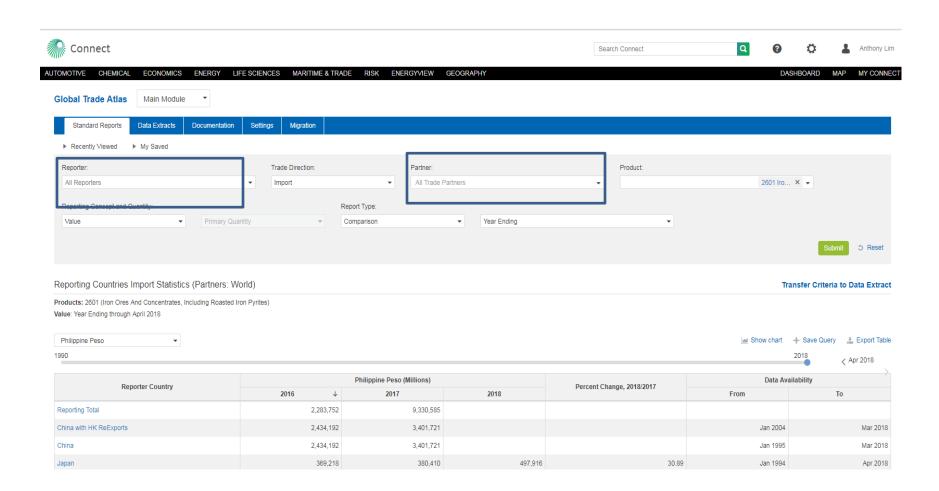
1) Go to "settings" tab to customize your search page. You can set for currency, time series, etc.




- 2) The "standard reports" is the search page. Users can input "all reporters" or any reporting country.


 The last few search queries will be listed. Or users can search directory or create their own country groups.
- 3) The above replicates itself for partner country search.




4) User can input H S code or commodity description or crated product groups in the product search. There is no limit to the number of commodity/H S code searches.




5) User can opt for either primary qty or secondary qty when using qty as a reporting concept. Users can choose both primary & secondary qty in data extract.




- 6) For "Annual +" in legacy GTA, it is replaced by "year ending" on Connect. Choose "comparison" as the report type.
- 7) Use the time scale slider to adjust the different time periods.




8) In the EDF module, the choice of the option is on the lower right. It is available for ports & states/districts.

- 11) Users can transfer saved query direct to data extract.

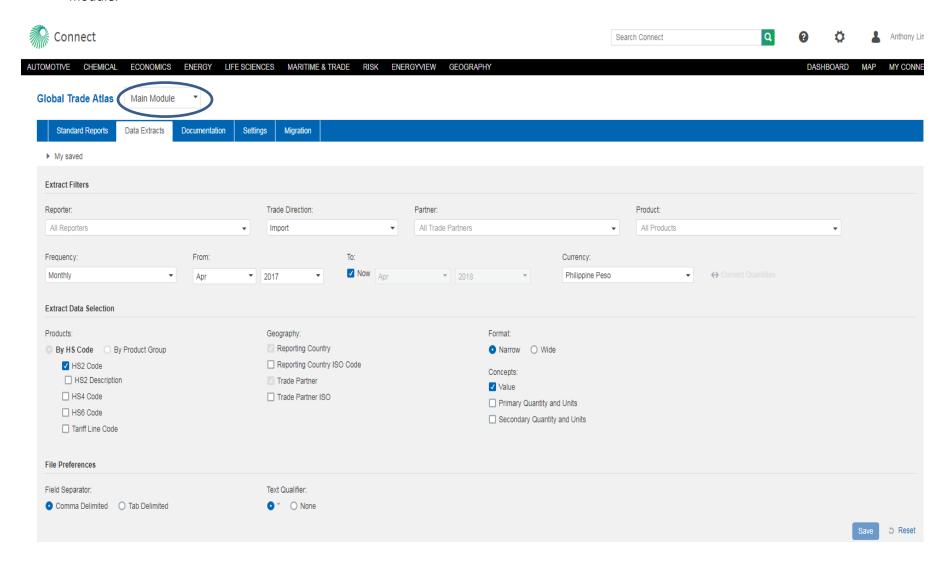

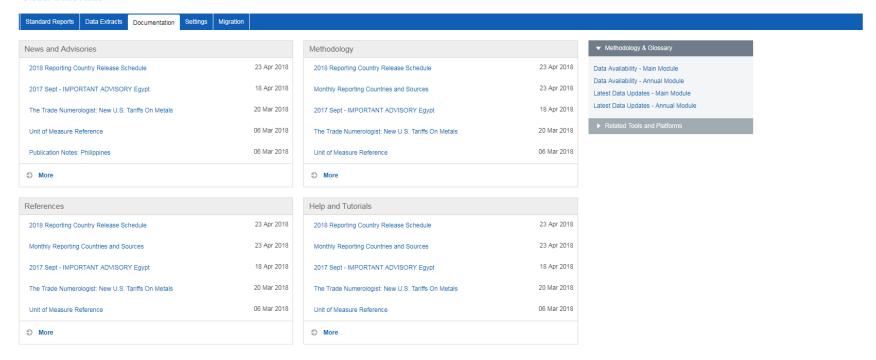
